#### About the SDG Flag Campaign

On 25 September 2023, it will have been exactly 8 years since the adoption of the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by 193 UN member states. The SDGs provide a historic opportunity to unite all global stakeholders to end extreme poverty, address inequality & injustice and protect our planet.

We are at the halfway point of Agenda 2030. Now is the time to increase the momentum to implement the SDGs and show our commitment to this global universal agenda.

From 25 - 30 September 2023, Global Compact Network South Africa will join organisations, municipalities, companies, civil society organisations, and schools all around the world in raising the SDG Flag to show support for the Sustainable Development Goals. You are invited to get involved in this global movement working #TogetherfortheSDGs. By raising the SDG Flag you are showing your commitment to the SDGs and increasing awareness of Agenda 2030.

**Participate** in this virtual campaign by uploading a photo or video of the SDG Flag and sharing it on social media with the hashtag #TogetherfortheSDGs. The campaign is scheduled to extend over a span of one week from **25 - 30 September 2023**; However, you are welcome to raise the SDG flag beyond this duration. The SDG Flag campaign is open to everyone.

The campaign was initiated by UN Global Compact as a call to companies everywhere to align their operations and strategies with the Ten Principles in the areas of human rights, labour, environment, and anti-corruption and to take action in support of the SDGs.

We hope that by raising the SDG Flag, companies, civil society organisations, educational institutions, and government organisations alike will show their commitment to the SDGs and the action that they're already taking to combat major global challenges.



### How to participate: Steps for action

- 1. Download the SDG flag images and videos; find all the resources here
- 2. Post the flags on your social media accounts using the hashtag #TogetherforSDGs
- 3. Share your photos and videos on social media
  - a. Post the SDG flag and take the opportunity to share what your organisation is doing to advance the SDGs
  - b. We are focusing our communications on **25 September 2023 30 September 2023**, but feel free to continue sharing for as long as you wish

- Discuss how your team, management, colleagues, or even partner organisations can participate in the SDG Flag Campaign.

- Engage your stakeholders, including your supply chains, consumers, and the local community in your SDG actions.
- Challenge colleagues to come up with creative solutions for SDG implementation within your organisation.
